Nader Rifai is a Professor of Pathology at Harvard Medical School, the Louis Joseph Gay-Lussac Chair in Laboratory Medicine, and Director of Clinical Chemistry at Boston Children's Hospital. His research has focused on biomarkers of cardiovascular disease. However, in the last decade his main interest has shifted to communication of scientific information and E-learning. He is the Editor-in-Chief of Clinical Chemistry, the Founder and Chair of Clinical Chemistry Trainee Council, and the Senior Editor of Tietz Textbook of Clinical Chemistry and Molecular Diagnostics.

Directions to the Hilton Garden Inn in Waltham:

From Route 93 (Boston or New Hampshire): Take 93 South to I-95/128 South, Follow to Route 128/95 South to Exit 27A - Totten Pond Road. At the end of the exit ramp turn right onto Totten Pond Road. Proceed one quarter of a mile to the entrance of the second office park on your right. Turn right and proceed up the driveway, and bear left to the hotel entrance.
