Dr. Horowitz received his bachelor's degree in chemistry from Harvard College in 1972 and his medical degree from Harvard Medical School in 1976. He completed a clinical pathology residency at Beth Israel Hospital in Boston in 1981, after which he became the Director of Clinical Chemistry at that institution, a position he held until 2017. At that time, he moved to the Department of Pathology and Laboratory Medicine at Tufts Medical Center and Tufts University School of Medicine, where he is currently Chief of Laboratory Medicine and Professor of Pathology.

He served as a member of the Chemistry Resource Committee of the College of American Pathologists from 2002 through 2006, and he then served two 4-year terms as Chair of that committee. He has been an active member of the CAP Accuracy-Based Testing Committee since its inception several years ago, and he became its Chair in January, 2019.

Dr. Horowitz has also worked with the Clinical Laboratory Standards Institute (CLSI): he was Chair of the working group on Document C28 (Reference Intervals) and was Vice-Chair of the working group on Document GP27 (Using Proficiency Testing to Improve the Clinical Laboratory).

His professional interests include reference intervals, informatics, automation, and kidney disease.
