AACC Divisions

Divisions provide a forum for the exchange of ideas and experiences among scientists and clinicians in specialized areas of laboratory medicine. Division membership includes access to the division newsletter, web site, listservs, educational activities, and awards and grants programs. Whatever your skill level or interest, divisions provide a rich environment for professional contacts and leadership opportunities. You may join one or more Divisions by indicating your choice on your Membership Dues Application, and enclosing the appropriate dues amount.

Animal Clinical Chemistry **\$25/year**

Promotes and encourages the study and improvement of the practice of clinical laboratory science in animals. Provides a vital forum for continuing education, networking opportunities, methods of analysis, reference intervals for different species and selection of appropriate research models.

Clinical and Diagnostic Immunology **\$15/year**

For members interested in clinical immunology and/or the use of immunological techniques in laboratory medicine. Topics addressed include allergic and autoimmune disorders; diagnosis of infectious disease; endocrinology and tumor markers.

Clinical Translational Science **\$20/year**

Provides a means for AACC members to collaboratively focus on their clinical and translational science interests. Topics of interest range from basic bench research through clinical trials to clinical practice. The listserv and linked-in access facilitate continuing education and provide networking benefits to the division and AACC members with the goal of reducing the bench to bedside transition time.

Critical and Point-of-Care Testing **\$20/year**

Provides a forum for the dissemination of information about critical care and point-of-care testing and its alternatives and encourages research in methodologies suitable for use at the point-of-care and in costs and outcomes of point-of-care testing. Maintains liaison with federal and state regulatory agencies and other professional societies with related interests.

History of Clinical Chemistry **\$15/year**

Promotes the preservation of our heritage in clinical chemistry and the history of the AACC. Projects include publication of books and articles, oral histories, exhibits, museums, and lectures.

Industry **\$15/year**

Provides a forum for meeting between industry-based and clinical laboratory members to identify common interests and develop programs.

Laboratory Information Systems and Medical Informatics **\$15/year**

Develops partnerships with other divisions, industry and other professional associations to promote a global standardized information environment in healthcare. Provides leadership to the association in matters of information science, technology and the integration of clinical laboratory data using laboratory information systems, middleware and other informatics tools.

Lipoproteins and Vascular Diseases **\$20/year**

Forum for laboratorians, clinicians, other scientists and industry representatives on issues related to vascular disease such as arteriosclerosis, coronary artery disease, and stroke.

Management Sciences **\$15/year**

Forum for communication and education on the management of clinical labs including finance, marketing, personnel, information systems, government regulations, legal issues and communications.

Molecular Pathology **\$15/year**

Molecular Pathology is an explosive and dynamic growth area of nucleic acid testing that spans genetics, pharmacogenetics, identity and HLA testing, bacterial and viral disease detection, and cancer marker identification. The wide experiences of our members are discussed vigorously on our active listserv. Topics range from the newest clinical applications of RT-PCR to validation procedures of microarray to CAP requirements for the growing need for proficiency testing.

Nutrition **\$15/year**

Nutrition research, education and laboratory monitoring of patients' nutritional status. Involved in standardizing existing methods for assessing the vitamin, mineral, lipid and protein status of patients and healthy individuals and developing new methods for assessing nutritional deficiencies.

Pediatric and Maternal-Fetal **\$20/year**

Promotes the study and practice of clinical chemistry from the perinatal period to adolescence. Interest areas include reference value surveys, testing for genetic disorders, prenatal screening, evaluating fetal lung maturity, and developing investigative protocols.

Proteomics Division **\$15/year**

Promotes the development of clinical proteomics through education, professional interchange, and the open exchange of information relating to the development of proteomic diagnostics and clinical biomarker applications.

Therapeutic Drug Management and Toxicology **\$15/year**

For members interested in therapeutic drug monitoring/management, and/or toxicology, including pharmacology, pharmacogenetics/genomics, clinical toxicology, forensic toxicology, environmental toxicology, and occupational toxicology. Division activities cover aspects of laboratory practice including analytical processes, laboratory management, education and research. The Division provides a forum for education and the exchange of information through its website, listserv, newsletter, and continuing education programs.
