

Rocky Mountain AACC Local Section Student Membership Scholarship Information

The Rocky Mountain Section of AACC is sponsoring up to 25 Student Memberships to the American Association of Clinical Chemistry, each in the amount of \$25.

The criteria for the **Student Membership Scholarship** are as follows:

- Applicant must be eligible to become a member of the Rocky Mountain Section of AACC. (AACC members with home or work addresses located within the Rocky Mountain section territory are automatically Rocky Mountain Section members.)

- Applicant must submit a statement of purpose explaining why he/she would like to be a member of AACC.

The \$25 can be applied to either a Full Membership or a Student Associate Membership.

Types of AACC Membership:

Full Member – \$185

Membership is open to persons holding an earned baccalaureate or higher degree in science, medicine, or academic equivalent, and engaged in professional activities commonly associated with clinical chemistry. Membership includes a subscription to Clinical Chemistry Journal.

Student Associate Member – \$25

Membership is open to undergraduate or graduate students engaged in full-time academic studies, residents, and fellows. All member benefits will be available, except voting privileges and the opportunity to hold Association office.

Applications:

The application deadline is November 30, 2009 for a scholarship for 2010 (beginning Jan. 1).

Candidates will be notified by e-mail of the decision by Dec 15.

An individual may be eligible for a student scholarship for a maximum of 3 years. This scholarship may be applied to either a student membership or part of a full membership.
