



Diagnostic testing algorithm for assessing thyroid function in pregnancy. High-risk patients include: personal or family history of thyroid disease, clinical signs and/or symptoms of thyroid disease, presence of goiter on physical exam, >30 years age, high body mass index, type 1 diabetes or presence of other autoimmune disorders, thyroid peroxidase antibody positive, previous head or neck irradiation, history of preterm birth, miscarriage, infertility, patient from iodine deficient region. (*) Determined utilizing assay and trimester specific reference ranges representative of the patient population
