New Developments in Colorectal Cancer Screening is the second of 12 programs in AACC's "Cutting Edge Technologies, Common Sense Solutions" webinar series. New colorectal cancer screening guidelines recommend moving from traditional guaiac fecal occult blood tests to newer assays such as high sensitivity fecal immunochemical tests for hemoglobin. Attend this webinar and learn what advantages the new fecal immunochemical tests for hemoglobin have compared to traditional screening tests, and why automated quantitation of fecal hemoglobin concentrations is important in screening programs and for individuals.
